Good morning Mr. Timms:

Please could the following questions be raised at the meeting of the Council of TOK (Council) on Monday Jun2 17th, 2024 regarding item 9.10 on the meeting agenda. These questions are being submitted prior to noon on Monday 17th, 2024.

- 1.How does the TOK ensure that compliance with the conditions of the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal (LPAT) decision PL170998 (“PL170998”) are achieved in any agreements, such as the Agreement?
- 2.Kingscross Ratepayers Association (KRA) was a party to PL170998. Please share the Terms of Reference for a Groundwater and Private Well monitoring and contingency program required as PL170998 Condition #61 (the “Program”) with KRA.
- 3.Please confirm that the Well Monitoring Program has commenced or will commence before any construction on the Sanitary Pumping Station is initiated, and please share the results of the monitoring required and the water balance information from the Program.
- 4.What is the \$ amount of the security required to satisfy condition #62 of PL170998 given that site works will commence with the construction of a sanitary pumping station should the Report be received, and the Agreement be signed by the Mayor and yourself.
- 5.For lay members of the community what will the construction of the sanitary pumping station involve e.g., what are the preparative steps which must be taken for such construction, what does construction entail, look like, sound like?
