7.1 Policy Planning Division Presentation

Aloma Dreher, Project Manager - Policy Planning, provided a slide presentation overview of the 2051 Official Plan (OP) Draft Discussion Paper Review commenting on; the timeline and stages for the Official Plan Review, public engagement, what an Official Plan is, guiding growth in King, living in King, King's overall vision for the Township, working in King, moving and connecting in King, and next steps.

- 1. That the presentation by the Policy Planning Division be received for information; and
- 2. That the following comments be provided for consideration:
 - Increase the minimum number of allocated barrier-free parking spaces in the Official Plan and subsequent Zoning By-laws to accommodate the growing number of persons living with some for of disability now and in the future
 - Increase the size of the parking spaces inorder to meet the needs of the larger sized mobility vehicles
 - Ensure developers asks for reducing the number of barrier-free parking spaces and size of spaces based on the set minimum criteria, don't get approved
 - Ensure parkland space is included with a focus on accessible parkland spaces
 - Roads and sidewalks when designed need to incorporate curb cuts
 - Set sufficient distance/separation criteria from bike lanes and sidewalks for safety

- All signalized intersections, pedestrian walkways, and rail crossings include audible signalizing to indicate when it is safe to cross and in which direction they may cross (York Region is moving to an Accessible Pedestrian Signals (APS) system at all regional crossings)
- Work with York Region to ensure adequate transportation services are provided as the population in King grows
- Commercial/employment should be developed where transportation services are provided
