Good morning,

I live at the corner of [REDACTED] and applaud the speed bump initiative, as is it critical to the safety and enjoyment of our neighbourhood.

I have lived here for almost 8 years and have seen this neighbourhood grow. In addition to the extreme speeding that has been going on on Tatton Court for some time, since the McDonalds has come in, both Tatton Court and Wells Orchard Crescent have experienced in my opinion a 5-fold increase in traffic, as many people going to McDonalds cut through our neighborhood from King Road, rather than access McDonalds off Dufferin St.

The Issue:

The speed bumps (2) in question as proposed to be placed on Tatton Court between Stan Roots and Wells Orchard. **This will NOT solve the issue.** It will simply route more traffic down Wells Orchard Crescent (from Stan Roots to Tatton Court) so motorists avoid the speed bumps on Tatton Court.

Proposed Solution:

At least one (1) speed bump (I propose 2) must be placed on Tatton Court between Wells Orchard Crescent and the McDonalds. I propose the additional speed bump(s) are placed close to the Montessori school in order to slow down traffic near the school, and to prevent traffic traveling down Wells Orchard Crescent in order to avoid the 2 proposed speed bumps on Tatton Court.
