To King Councillors, and the King Township Mayor:

I have resided in the Schomberg area my whole life. People in Schomberg have always considered development in appropriate areas of our town. Some examples of appropriate development and zoning are: the Kitchen Brendon Manor, and my current condo building of 65 units [REDACTED]. Each of these development opportunities allowed many older King Township residents to downsize and continue to live in an area they loved. The last condo built in the ravine area did not interfere with local residents, or create traffic chaos. In fact, it was built where a former alfalfa (and then hops mill) was based.

This new proposed development would impact the Dufferin Marsh, cause traffic chaos, and cause major issues for Schomberg Main St. businesses. I also feel that the developer has made no meaningful changes to the proposed development since the community meeting. I feel that a zoning change would not preserve the historic Schomberg Main St. and have extreme environmental impact on the town and Marsh.
