As a past co chair of the Schomberg 55+ Club and presently a member of the King Township Committee on an Age Friendly Community, my husband George and I am opposed to the proposed development on 326 Main Street for two reasons.

1. It is not feasible, in our opinion to provide 106 parking spaces for 99 units. How many units might have two cars? All units will also inevitably have visitors!

This overflow of vehicles will drastically affect our Main Street which is already overflowing with congested traffic and limited parking for local shoppers.

2. Schomberg 55 + Club meets in the Schomberg Community Hall directly across the street two to three days a week. It is already difficult for members to find convenient parking near the hall.

At my last attendance, I ended up walking from the Schomberg Pub to the hall. Not all members are able to do this and my concern is that the overflow of vehicles mentioned above will create further parking problems for our members and all our local businesses.
