By-Law Number 2025-073

A By-law to Implement the Temporary Closure of Toll Road between Bathurst Street and Canal Road

Whereas the Regional Municipality of York has commenced urgent structural repairs to the Holland River Bridge, located at the boundary of the Township of King and the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury; and

Whereas the bridge is jointly owned by York Region and Simcoe County, and the rehabilitation work is necessary to maintain the structural integrity of the bridge and ensure public safety; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Township of King deems it prudent to support the Region's efforts by implementing a temporary road closure to facilitate construction and reduce safety risks to road users;

Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of the Township of King enacts as follows:

1. **That** Toll Road between Bathurst Street and Canal Road be restricted to local traffic only during the following periods:
 - a. November 13, 2025, to December 19, 2025
 - b. July 2, 2026, to October 31, 2026
2. **That** the temporary road closing referred to in this By-law shall not prohibit necessary use of the road for essential vehicles, including emergency services.

Read a First and Second time this 27th day of October 2025.

Read a Third time and finally passed this 27th day of October 2025.
