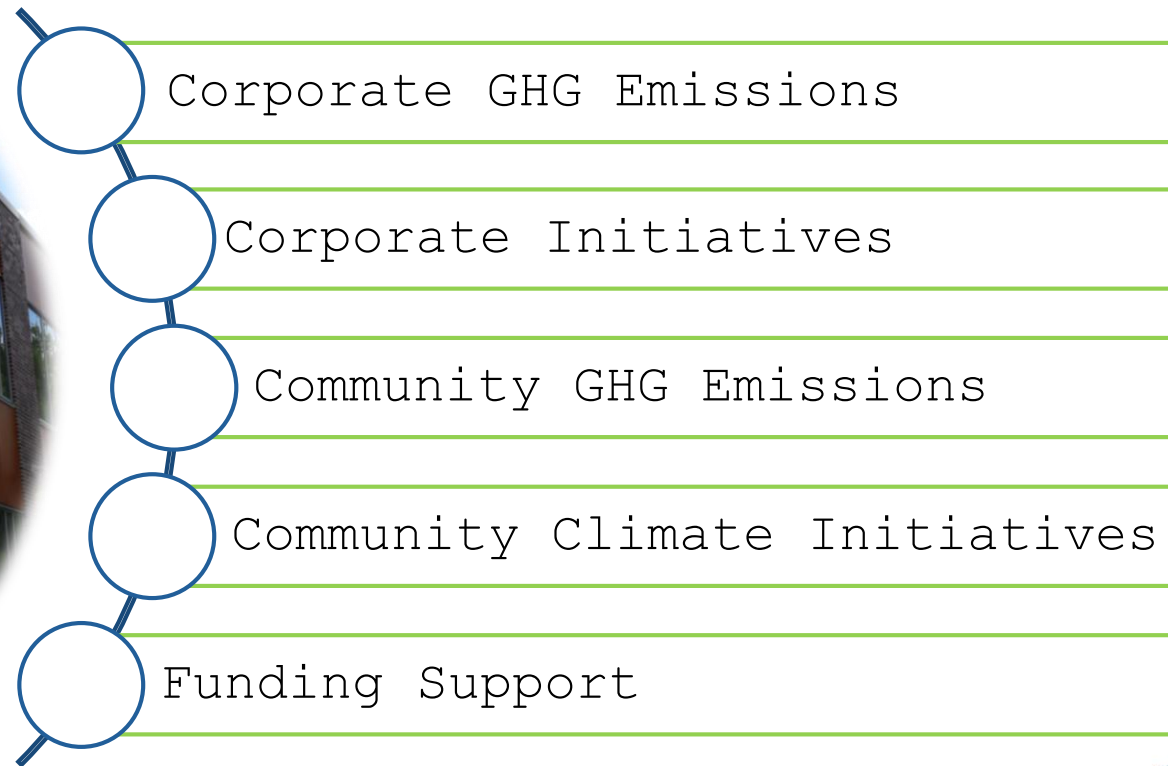

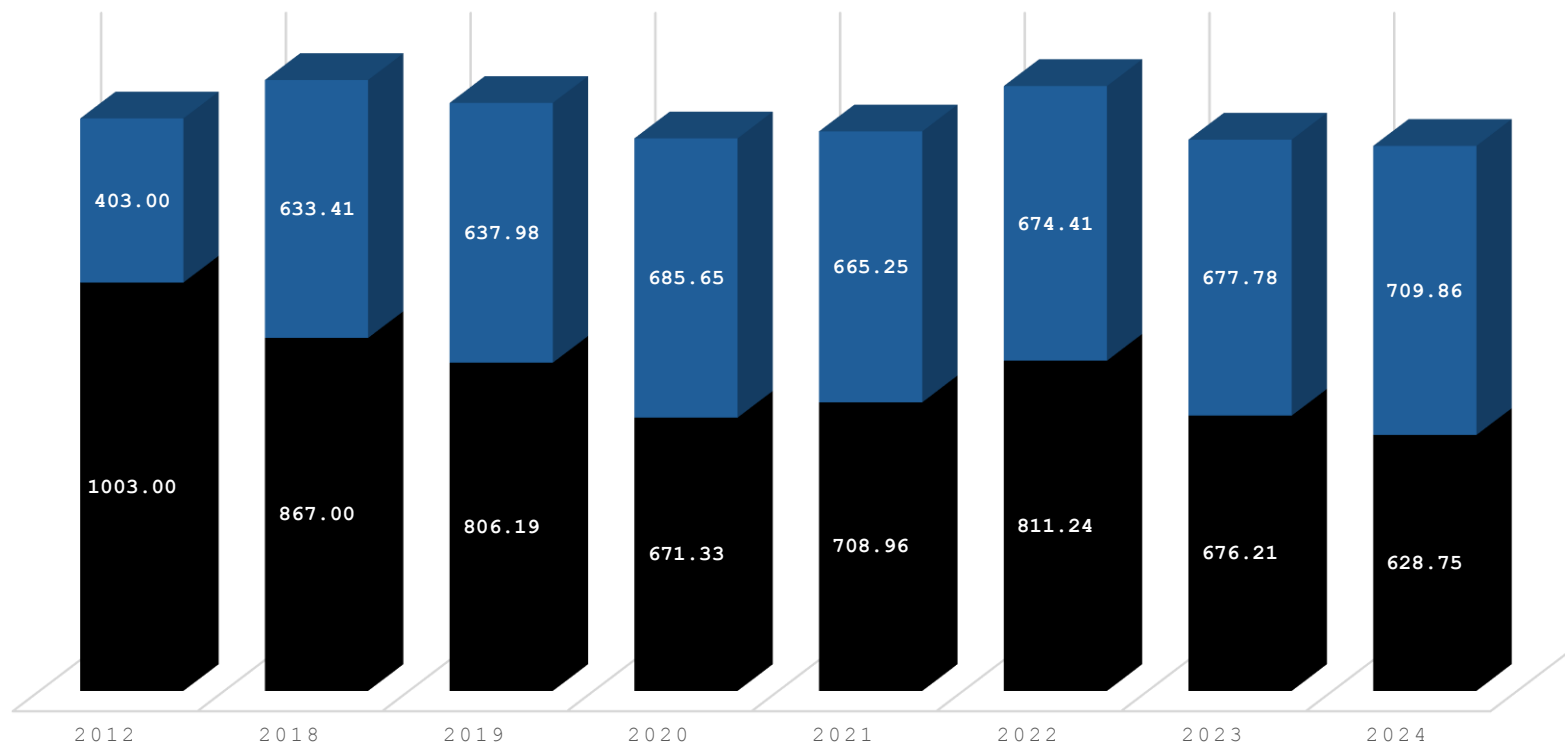

BUILDINGS AND FLEET STACKED

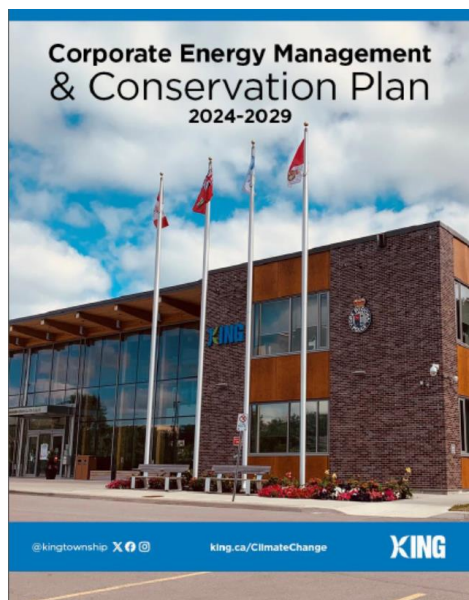
