Description: Following the incident, a resident of [REDACTED] came outside and indicated the she had heard "all of the commotion" and asked the young lady who had fallen down while trying to hold onto her dog "are you okay".

Describe the occurrence: On Friday August 16, 2024 at approximately 6:20 p.m. I (Gary Williams) was cutting our grass with my lawn tractor on the boulevard between my house and my neighbour's house. I saw a young lady having trouble holding on to her dog as he was pulling on his leash on the north side of Patricia Drive at [REDACTED]. As the dog was pulling on his leash, the young lady fell down and the dog became free from her and ran across the street to [REDACTED] where he began jumping up on a gentleman who had picked up his dog. At this point, I put my lawn tractor in park, got off and ran towards the dog who was jumping up on the gentleman (who was holding his dog in his arms). By the time I had gotten to the dog who became free from the young lady, the young lady had gotten up and proceeded across the street where she grabbed her dog's leash and began to attend to her dog. While this was happening, the gentleman holding his dog in his arms was walking west on Patricia Drive. When I got to the young lady and her dog, I asked her "are you okay"? she indicated "yes" and said that her dog "gets excited when he sees other dogs", I spoke to her dog, I told him "You're okay", he appeared friendly, and he began to calm down. I walked with the young lady and her dog towards my house [REDACTED] and the dog wanted to play with me. I asked the young lady if she lived on Patricia Drive and she indicated that she lived with her parents at the house next to the one under construction [REDACTED]. I asked the young lady her name and she indicated it was Senna (spelling?) I also asked her what her dog's name was and she indicated it was Bear. I told the young lady my name was "Gary and I live right here (standing in the driveway of [REDACTED]), as the young lady proceeded towards her house, I said to her "take care" went back to my lawn tractor and resumed cutting the grass.
